Highland Heights Presbyterian PDO/Pre-K

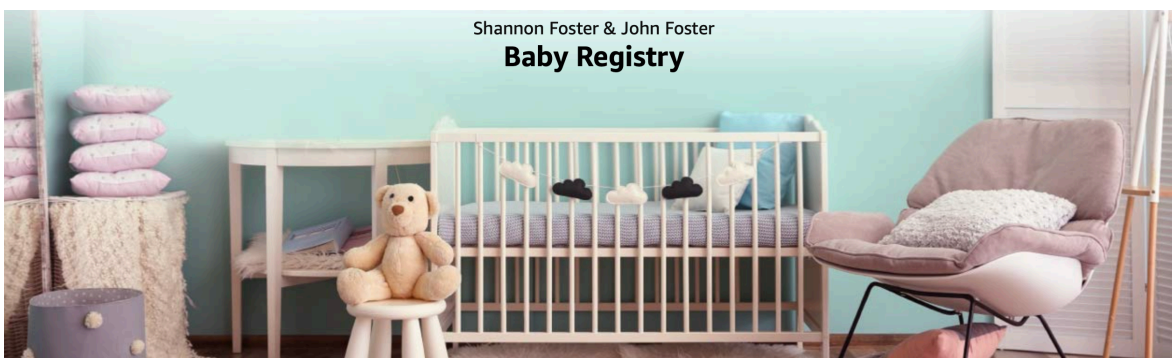
We had a wonderful preschool graduation on May 20th!

Be sure to ask Abbi England about her trip to Paris. She is traveling with her parents.

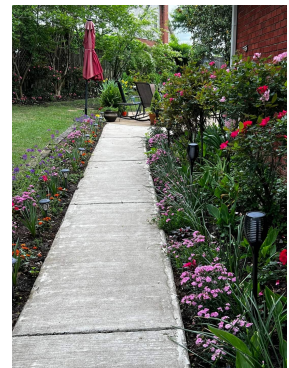
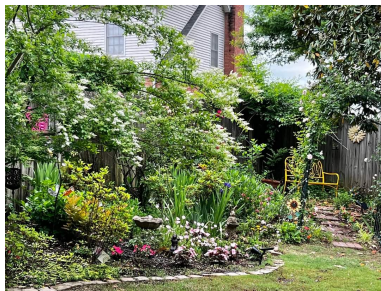


A COLLIERVILLE CABOOSE DELIGHT

- 1) The elders gratefully accepted Carol Hendrian's offer to be HHPC's **Church Nurse**, a volunteer position for which she has the training and one she has held in other churches. They also approved her recommendation to **purchase a defibrillator**.
- 2) Mel Clark is the new **Security Team Leader**. To volunteer on the team, contact Mel at 901 335-9381.
- 3) The elders approved the request of a local **Home School non-profit** to have resource meetings at the Church once a month during the school year.
- 4) On Sundays when the Lord's Supper is observed, as an expression of gratitude to God and renewed love for others, **an offering for the poor and needy** is going to be collected. In doing so, Highland Heights is recovering an old Presbyterian practice.
- 5) The **new hardware on the back of the front doors** has been installed ... "Here's the Church, here's the steeple, **open the doors**, and there are all the people!"
- 6) **Vacation Bible School** will be Monday-Thursday, June 13-16, 5:30-8:00 pm. for ages 4 and up. Supper will be served each night from 5:30-6:00 pm.
- 7) The annual **Trivia Night** to raise funds for our adopted orphanage in Kenya will be Friday night, July 15.
- 8) **From Memphis to Kenya** - \$30/month per HHPC family helps to feed the 100+ children in our adopted orphanage in Kenya. Are you giving to this important ministry?
- 9) **General Ministry Fund** income through April 30 was \$144,070 and expenses were \$136,345 for a surplus of \$7,725. The **General Ministry Fund balance** on April 30 was \$85,216.
