

Elders' Notes from July 19, 2022

- 1) On May 29, **Joyce Emery joined the Church** by Reaffirmation of Faith in Jesus Christ, and **Mary Ann & Steve Cole joined the Church** by transfer of membership from Cordova Presbyterian Church.
- 2) Gratitude was expressed to Children's Ministry Director Lesa Hart and her team for their hard work on Vacation Bible School last month.
- 3) Gratitude was expressed to **Jason & Traci Gatlin and their team for their hard work on Trivia Night.** \$7,150 has been raised so far. August 1 is the deadline to reach the \$10,000 goal to build a boys' dormitory at our adopted orphanage in Kenya. The amount we raise will be matched!
- 4) Gratitude was expressed to Dennis & Barbara Glaze for designing, building and painting the new Bell Choir cabinet on the Chancel.
- 5) Approval was given to Rev. Bob & Barb James' request to increase the amount sent to feed the children at our adopted orphanage in Kenya. Beginning in August, an additional \$200/month will be sent, which increases our support from \$1,300/month to \$1,500/month.
- 6) Due to inflation, **Fall enrollment is down in Parents' Day Out.** Classes begin August 8/9 and meet on M/W and T/Th, and there are openings for one or two children in many of the rooms. Tuition is \$220/month for one child and \$170/month for each additional child. Please help recruit and pray for this important outreach ministry of HHPC.
- 7) **From Memphis to Kenya -** \$30/month per HHPC family helps to feed the 100+ children in our adopted orphanage in Kenya. Are you giving to this important ministry?
- 8) **General Ministry Fund** income through June 30 was \$214,097 and expenses were \$216,174 for a difference of \$2,077. The **General Ministry Fund balance** on June 30 was \$75,414.
